Dear Parents,


August is here bringing along with it excitement and cheer! It was indeed a pleasure to see our little ones settle so well to the new routine of online classes after the summer break!!






Here is a short summary of the activities planned for this month:

Reading Skills






- * Introduction and Vocabulary exercises for letters ${\bf b}$ and ${\bf r}$ through interesting activities


