

Orientation for BOARD EXAM 2021





Punctuality

- Students should reach the exam center one hour prior to the commencement of the exam. **Please be at the centre by 9.15 am.**
- Add extra thirty minutes in your travel time on the days of exam for main subjects such as English, Mathematics, Political Science etc. since number of students appearing in these subjects is more, hence the traffic is heavy.
- Students are generally allowed to enter the exam center around 9:30 am.
Reading time: 10:15am to 10:30 am
Writing time: 10:30 am to 1:30 pm.





Admit Card

- Admit card **should not be laminated** and should be carried with you on each exam day.
- Students are advised to keep some **photocopies of the admit card.**



A Must

- **Permitted items:**

Students need to be in proper school uniform for the exam and must carry the following:

- **Stationery required (preferably in a transparent pouch)**
- **Admit Card**
- **Bottle of water**
- **Mask**
- **Face Shield (if desired)**
- **Sanitizer**



Caution

- **Prohibited items:**

Students are not allowed to carry :

- Any electronic items like mobile phones, calculators, smartwatches, etc
- Any kind of textbooks/material.
- Digital watches (including smart watches) are also not permitted. Only **analog watches** are permitted.
- Any bags or writing board



Safety Precautions

- Mask to be worn at all times.
- Carry water/juice in a transparent water bottle. No sharing of things would be permitted.
- Maintain social distancing.



Filling in details

- Fill the first sheet of the main answer booklet very carefully.
- **Roll number to be written carefully** on the main answer sheet, the continuation sheet and nowhere else.
- **Only blue coloured pen** to be used for writing.
- Do not underline with a red / pink pen. Only use pencil/black/blue pen for underlining.



Discipline

- Students should not talk to their friends in the corridors/ washroom during the exam. Any complaint against the student will be dealt with strictly and may result in punitive measures by the centre.
- Students should carry their own stationery. It should not be borrowed.
- Discipline should be maintained at all times and instructions of the invigilator should be followed.



No Cheating

- Do not think or try to use unfair means at all. It may lead to debarring from giving the exam for next 3 years.
