
Class VIII Parent's interaction with the Principal

Academics

In case of any connectivity issues, the subject teacher or class teacher must be informed immediately and the images of the answer sheet should be immediately mailed or sent by whatsApp which can later be converted to pdf and attached to the assignment on Google Classroom as soon as possible.
