





Introduction of two levels of Mathematics for All India Secondary School Examination from the Academic Session ending March, 2020 onwards.

- Two levels of Examination will be held in the subject of Mathematics in the Board examination for Class X in the year 2020 and the same shall not be applicable to the internal assessment in class X.
- First level would be the same as the existing one- **Standard level**, and the other would be an easier level- **Basic level**.
- The Standard level will be meant for <u>students who wish to opt for</u>
 <u>Mathematics at Sr. Secondary level</u> and the Basic level would be for students not keen to pursue Mathematics at higher levels.
- A student will have the <u>right to choose</u> between the two levels of Examination only till the time of registration.





Warning Signs To Look Out For

- Your child becomes obsessive/secretive about being online.
- Your child receives phone calls from people you do not know or makes calls to numbers that you do not recognize
- They suddenly stop doing school work or start missing classes

- Your child receives gifts, mail, or packages from someone you do not know
 - Your child withdraws from family and friends
 - Look out for any sudden change in appearance /clothing that covers /suspicious injuries

- Weight loss or gain and lack of hygiene may be a sign of emotional distress
- Your child changes screens or turns off computer when an adult enters a room
 - They get angry when he or she can't get online
