Notice for Parents - Online Safety and Cyberbullying

As the summer break has begun and children spend more time online, we must emphasize that you routinely monitor your ward's internet presence. Unfiltered access to other students and the relative anonymity of the internet can be a fertile environment for many forms of cyberbullying. (Cyberbullying is using the internet, a mobile phone or other technology like a camera to hurt somebody or embarrass them).

It is your responsibility to make your ward aware of the consequences of engaging in such behaviour and educate them on internet etiquettes. What is put online remains permanently. Malicious online behaviour can have legal/penal consequences and might be very detrimental to their future prospects.
