Dear Parents

Middle School students would start school from Monday , **February 14, 2022. Timings of the school would be from 7:30 am to 12:40 pm.**

Class VIII students shall enter and disperse the school from Gate No. 4. Classes VI & VII students shall enter and disperse from Gate No. 5. They must carry their consent form (attached below), books for the day, sanitizers, mask and lunchbox. Students must come in proper school uniform.

Parents are requested to make requisite transport arrangements and try to reach 10-15 minutes early to avoid rush and traffic at the school gate.

Please note that classes will be conducted in the hybrid mode (offline and online both).

Safety measures include:

- i. Physical distancing of at least 6 feet to be followed as far as feasible.
- ii. Mandatory use of face covers/masks- N95.
- iii. Frequent hand washing with soap (for at least 40-60 seconds) even when hands are not visibly dirty. Use of alcohol-based hand sanitizers (for at least 20 seconds) can be done wherever feasible.
- iv. Respiratory etiquettes to be strictly followed. This involves strict practice of covering one's mouth and nose while coughing/sneezing with a tissue/handkerchief/flexed elbow and disposing off used tissues properly.
- v. Self-monitoring of health by all and reporting any illness at the earliest.
- vi. Spitting shall be strictly prohibited.
