'Literary Day' Foreign Languages


Literary Day for the Foreign Languages was held on December 3, 2021 for grades 6 and 8 in the zero period. Children were grouped housewise and were made to do several activities:

- Grade 6 students prepared Ecards on the theme "Christmas and New Year. The Objective of this activity was to teach them new vocabulary and expressions in the respective languages .
- Grade 8 French students did an integrated activity with a lesson they are doing in Social Studies on the Environment. This activity was done housewise. The students prepared a Google slide Presentation on How to protect the environment using expressions they have learnt in French.
- The Objective of this lesson was to learn the vocabulary and spellings, and express the points using the correct tenses. This activity also helped strengthen their Linguistic skills.
- Grade 8 German students made an EBrochure on 4 most beautiful cities of Germany (1 city per house) highlighting the features which make those the most distinguished cities of Germany. Children showcased their talent by putting their IT knowledge to the best use and coming up with creative ideas. 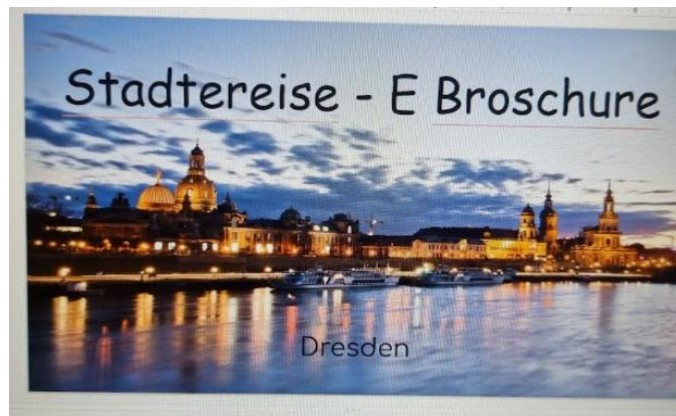

Geography of Dresden - Vandan

Dresden is a large city in the eastern German state of Saxony.

Area: 328.8 sq km
Population: 556227

Dresden lies on both banks of the river Elbe, mostly in the Dresden Basin, with the further reaches of the eastern Ore Mountains to the south, the steep slope of the Lusatian granitic crust to the north and the Elbe Sandstone Mountains to the east at an elevation of about 113 metres.

The most important river in Dresden is the Elbe river, the only navigable body of water to flow through the city. There are also a number of tributaries such as the river Weißeritz.
