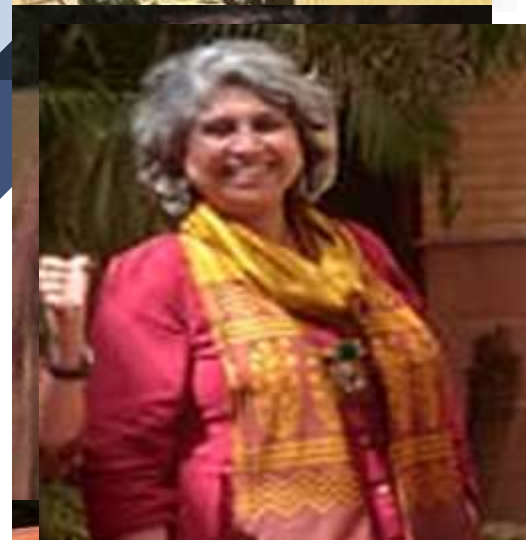

Two levels of Mathematics - Grade 10

Introduction of two levels of Mathematics for All India Secondary School Examination

Two levels of Examination will be held in the subject of Mathematics in the Board examination for Class X and the same shall not be applicable to the internal assessment in class X.

- First level would be the same as the existing one- **Standard level**, and the other would be an easier level- **Basic level**.
- The Standard level will be meant for **students who wish to opt for Mathematics at Sr. Secondary level** and the Basic level would be for students not keen to pursue Mathematics at higher levels.
- A student will have the **right to choose** between the two levels of Examination only till the time of registration.
